

Atlantic Cape and Rowan enter into transfer agreement for engineering

MAYS LANDING — Future engineering students at Rowan University can attend Atlantic Cape Community College for their associate's degree and easily transfer thanks to a new agreement signed by the two colleges Monday.

The articulation agreement allows students who complete an engineering degree at Atlantic Cape to transfer into the Henry M. Rowan College of Engineering at Rowan University as juniors in its mechanical engineering program. A cumulative grade point average of 3.5 is required for automatic acceptance. Students who do not meet this requirement but have a grade point average of 3.0 will be given strong consideration.

This signing marks the 31st articulation agreement that provides Atlantic Cape students an opportunity for seamless transfer to a four-year college or university.
